Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 1 Section 3 of Chapter 90C of the general laws is hereby amended by adding at
2 the end of Paragraph (4) of Subsection (A) the following:

3 In the event the violator is found innocent of the infraction, the court fee of \$25 will be
4 fully refunded.
