By Mr. Turner of Dennis and Senator Wolf, a joint petition (accompanied by bill, House, No. 3258) of Cleon H. Turner (by vote of the town) relative to the establishment of a Barrier Beach protection stabilization fund in the town of Dennis. Municipalities and Regional Government. [Local Approval Received.]

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year Two Thousand Eleven

An Act establishing a Barrier Beach Protection Stabilization Fund in the town of Dennis.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding section 53 of chapter 44 of the General Laws, or any
2 other general or special law, rule or regulation to the contrary, there shall be a special fund in the
3 town of Dennis to be known as the Barrier Beach Protection Stabilization Fund. There shall be
4 deposited into the fund, without further appropriation, monies in the amount of 20 percent of the
5 fees collected by the town of Dennis from the sale of Off Road Vehicle permits. The fund shall
6 be used exclusively for barrier beach protection, including law enforcement and restoration.

7 SECTION 2. The Barrier Beach Protection Stabilization Fund shall be maintained by the
8 town treasurer as a separate account, subject to any applicable provisions of chapter 44 of the
9 General Laws, and any interest accrued shall be credited to and become part of the fund.
