3 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, the town of

4 Yarmouth may impose a room occupancy tax, in addition to any such occupancy tax currently

allowed by law, on any vacation or leisure accommodation, including, but not limited to

6 apartments, single or multiple family housing, cottages, condominiums, bed and breakfasts and

time share units or any other such temporary occupancy not currently defined in chapter 64G of

8 the General Laws. Vacation or leisure accommodation is defined as occupancy for a period of 90

consecutive days or less, for a price to be intended and paid at the time of contract, regardless of

whether such use and possession is by a lessee, tenant, guest or licensee.
