An Act to establish the changing of determination standard for the Department of Children and Families.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           Section 51B of chapter 119 of the general laws, as appearing in the 2008 Official Edition,  
2   is hereby amended by striking out the words “reasonable cause to believe”, in lines 20, lines 22  
3   and 23, line 33, lines 39 and 40, line 50, lines 88 and 89 and in line 93, and inserting in place  
4   thereof, in each instance, the following words:- no reasonable doubt.
