An Act relative to certain exotic pets.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. The director of the division of fisheries and wildlife is hereby directed to
- 2 provide that sugar gliders are a species which are exempt from the licensing provisions of section
- 3 23 of chapter 131 of the General Laws and may be imported, possessed, maintained, propagated,
- 4 bought, sold, exchanged or offered for sale without a license or permit from the division.
