An Act relative to authorizing the town of Saugus to place a certain question relative to a real estate tax assessment for snow and ice removal costs on the town’s election ballot.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. The town of Saugus may hold a special election, prior to June 30, 2011, to  
2 request voter approval of a 1 year real estate tax assessment for the purpose of paying snow and  
3 ice removal costs incurred during fiscal year 2011. If approved by a majority of voters of the  
4 town, the assessment would be apportioned according to current classifications, assessments and  
5 tax rates; provided, however, that the total assessment shall not exceed the total cost of fiscal  
6 year 2011 snow and ice removal costs in the town of Saugus as certified by the town accountant  
7 prior to said election.

8           SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
