An Act Relative to Municipal Public Works Mutual Aid.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Section 4K of Chapter 40 of the General Laws is hereby amended by  
2 striking subsection (b) and inserting in place thereof the following:-

3           (b) There shall be a statewide public works municipal mutual aid agreement to facilitate  
4 the provision of public works resources across jurisdictional lines for and in the case of a public  
5 works incident and for maintenance that requires mutual aid assistance from 1 or more  
6 municipalities. The mutual aid assistance to be provided under the agreement shall include, but  
7 not be limited to, services related to public works, personnel, equipment, supplies and facilities  
8 to prepare for, prevent, mitigate, respond to and recover from public works incidents.
