An Act relative to the allocation of settlement funds.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Chapter 12 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2008 Official Edition, is hereby  
2 amended by inserting after section 5H the following section:-

3 Section 5H1/2. Each fiscal year the comptroller shall transfer any funds received by the  
4 attorney general through any third party settlement in the following amounts: (1) 25 per cent to  
5 the General Fund; (2) 25 per cent to the State Retiree Benefits Trust Fund established by section  
6 24 of chapter 32A; and (3) 50 per cent to the Commonwealth Stabilization Fund established  
7 pursuant to section 2H of chapter 29.
