An Act relative to certain utility rates.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1 Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, the Department  
2 of Public Utilities shall not amend, augment, eliminate or change in any manner prior to  
3 December 31, 2012 the so called “Schedule PR” as referenced in the Department of Public  
4 Utilities Order DPU 97-120. SECTION 2 Any rate payer part of “Schedule PR” as defined in  
5 section one shall not be removed from said schedule without the consent of the rate payer.
