Creem (by vote of the town) relative to the appointment of certain department heads and employees in the town of Brookline. Municipalities and Regional Government. [Local Approval Received.]

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year Two Thousand Eleven

An Act Amending Chapter 270 of the Acts of 1985, as amended by Chapter 322 of the Acts of 1900 and Chapter 427 of the Acts of 1991.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Notwithstanding the provisions of any general or special law or general by-law to the
2 contrary, Chapter 270 of the Acts of 1985, as amended, is hereby further amended by amending
3 Section 2(b) as follows:

4 Strike the comma and add the word “and” after the phrase “park and recreation
5 commission” and strike all language following the phrase “council on aging” and prior to the
6 phrase “and in making such recommendations”, said language referring to the rent control board.

7 And further amending Section 2 by inserting a new section denoted as Section 2(c)
8 immediately following existing Sections 2(a) and 2(b) as amended above, and retaining all
9 subsequent existing subsections of Section 2, appropriately renumbered, as follows:

10 Section 2(c). approval of the appointment of all other town employees, except employees
11 of the library, employees of the town clerk's office, employees of the school department, and
12 civil service employees who are subject to chapter thirty-one of the General Laws.

13 This act shall take effect upon its passage.
