An Act establishing a sick bank for Toby Miller..

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court

3 Whereas, The deferred operation of this act would tend to defeat its purpose, which is to
4 establish forthwith a sick leave bank for a certain employee of the executive office of health and
5 human services, therefore it is hereby declared to be an emergency law, necessary for the
6 immediate preservation of the public convenience.

8 Notwithstanding any general or special law, or rule, or regulation to the contrary, the
9 executive office of health and human services shall establish a sick leave bank for Toby Miller,
10 an employee of the office. Any employee of the office may voluntarily contribute 1 or more
11 sick, personal or vacation days to the sick leave bank for use by Toby Miller. Whenever Toby

12 Miller terminates employment with the office or requests to dissolve the sick leave bank, any
13 remaining time in the sick leave bank shall be transferred to the extended illness leave bank. Sick
14 leave bank days shall not be used for absences unrelated to the illness or disability that
15 necessitated the establishment of the sick leave bank as determined by the office of health and
16 human services.
