## The Commonwealth of Alassachusetts

In the Year Two Thousand Eleven

An Act establishing a sick bank for Matthew Robitaille...

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Notwithstanding any general or special law, or rule, or regulation to the contrary, the 2 Bristol county sheriff's office shall establish a sick leave bank for Matthew Robitaille, an 3 employee of the office, to allow him time to care for his children and injured wife. Any 4 employee of the Bristol county sheriff's office may voluntarily contribute 1 or more sick, 5 personal or vacation days to the sick leave bank for use by Matthew Robitaille. Whenever 6 Matthew Robitaille terminates employment with the Bristol county sheriff's office or requests to 7 dissolve the sick leave bank, any remaining time in the sick leave bank shall be transferred to the 8 extended illness leave bank. Sick leave bank days shall not be used for absences unrelated to the 9 illness or disability that necessitated the establishment of the sick leave bank as determined by 10 the Bristol county sheriff's office.
