

**HOUSE . . . . . No. 3497**

By Representative Hogan of Stow and Senator Flanagan, a joint petition (accompanied by bill, House, No. 3497) of Kate Hogan and Jennifer L. Flanagan (by vote of the town) for legislation to authorize the town of Bolton to grant an additional license for the sale of all alcoholic beverages to be drunk on the premises. Consumer Protection and Professional Licensure. [Local Approval Received.]

**The Commonwealth of Massachusetts**

**In the Year Two Thousand Eleven**

An Act authorizing the town of Bolton to grant a license for the sale of all alcoholic beverages to be drunk on the premises.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           Section 1. (a) Notwithstanding section 11 of Chapter 138 of the General Laws, or any  
2           vote cast in the town of Bolton pursuant to chapter 706 of the acts of 1967, chapter 386 of the  
3           acts of 1986 or chapter 146 of the acts of 1996, or any other special act or general law to the  
4           contrary, the licensing authority for the town of Bolton may grant a license for the sale of all  
5           alcoholic beverages to be drunk on the premises under section 12 of Chapter 138 to Wealyn LLC  
6           d/b/a The International Golf Club and Resort for the Premise located at 159 Ballville Road. The  
7           license shall be subject to all of said chapter 138 except said section 11 and 17. The license shall  
8           not be transferable off the premises.

9           (b) The licensing authority shall not approve the transfer of the license to any other  
10          location but it may grant the license to a new applicant at the same location if the applicant files

11 with the licensing authority a letter from the department of revenue indicating that the license is  
12 in good standing with the department and that all applicable taxes have been paid.

13 (c) If the license granted under this section is cancelled, revoked or no longer in use, it  
14 shall be returned physically, with all of the legal rights, privileges and restrictions pertaining  
15 thereto, to the licensing authority of the town of Bolton. The licensing authority may then grant  
16 the license to a new applicant at the same location subject to all of the procedures set forth under  
17 Section 15A of Chapter 138.

18 Section 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
