An act authorizing the town of Tyringham to continue the employment of Rainsford Morehouse, a member of the police department.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, Rainsford  
2   Morehouse, a member of the police department of the town of Tyringham, may continue in such  
3   position until August 6, 2015; provided, however, that Rainsford Morehouse is mentally and  
4   physically capable of performing the duties of the position. If requested, Rainsford Morehouse  
5   shall, at his own expense, be examined by an impartial physician designated by the town to  
6   determine his capacity.

7           SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage
