The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year Two Thousand Eleven

An Act establishing a sick leave bank for Arcelia Williams-Sullivan, an employee of the Massachusetts Rehabilitation Commission.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Notwithstanding any general or special law, rule or regulation to the contrary, the
2 Massachusetts rehabilitation commission shall establish a sick leave bank for Arcelia Williams-
3 Sullivan, an employee of the commission. Any employee of the commission may voluntarily
4 contribute 1 or more sick, personal or vacation days to the sick leave bank for use by Arcelia
5 Williams-Sullivan. Sick leave bank days shall not be used for absences unrelated to the illness or
6 disability that necessitated the establishment of the sick leave bank as determined by the
7 commission. Whenever Arcelia Williams-Sullivan terminates employment with the commission
8 or requests to dissolve the sick leave bank, any remaining time in the sick leave bank shall be
9 transferred to the extended illness leave bank.
