Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section 1. Section 29 of chapter 121B is hereby amended by striking the second
- 2 paragraph and inserting in its place thereof the following section:-
- In the development or administration of a project which is not federally aided, a housing
- 4 authority shall determine the rates of wages and fees, and payments to health and welfare plans
- 5 to be paid to laborers and mechanics or similar classifications of employment prevalent in the
- 6 city of town in which said housing authority is organized.
