**The Commonwealth of Massachusetts**

**In the Year Two Thousand Eleven**

An Act relative to restore funding for the police career pay program.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section 108L of chapter 41 is hereby amended by inserting at the end of the first  
2 paragraph the following 2 sentences:—

3 Any of the said regular full-time members hired after July 1st, 1976 shall be eligible for  
4 this program. Annual appropriated funding for this program shall not be below the amount  
5 appropriated in fiscal year 2008, or 50 per cent of the costs borne by the municipality contracted  
6 to provide funding of the program, whichever is greater.
