

HOUSE No. 3676

By Representative Calter of Kingston and Senator Murray, a joint petition (accompanied by bill, House, No. 3676) of Thomas J. Calter and Therese Murray (by vote of the town) that the town of Plympton be authorized to create the position of treasurer-collector. Municipalities and Regional Government. [Local Approval Received.]

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

An Act establishing the position of treasure-collector in the town of Plympton..

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of section 1 of chapter 41 or of any other
2 general or special law to the contrary, there shall be a treasurer-collector for the town of
3 Plympton. The treasurer-collector shall have all the powers, perform the duties and be subject to
4 the liabilities and penalties now or hereafter conferred and imposed by law on town treasurers
5 and town collectors of taxes. The treasurer-collector shall be appointed and may be removed,
6 after the opportunity for a hearing, by the board of selectmen of the town. The board of
7 selectmen may establish an employment contract with the treasurer-collector for salary, fringe
8 benefits and other conditions of employment, including, but not limited to, severance pay,
9 reimbursement for expenses incurred in the performance of the duties of office, liability
10 insurance, and conditions of discipline, termination, dismissal, reappointment, performance
11 standards and leave.

12 SECTION 2. Upon the effective date of this act the elected offices of town treasurer and
13 town collector shall be abolished and the terms of the incumbents of such offices terminated.
14 Provided, however, that notwithstanding the provisions of section 1 of this act, the incumbent
15 elected collector on the effective date of this act shall be the first appointee to the new combined
16 position of treasurer collector, and shall hold such office and perform the duties thereof until the
17 expiration of the term for which the collector was elected, unless such incumbent sooner vacates
18 such office. After the expiration of the term of the incumbent town collector holding office on
19 the effective date of this act, or a sooner vacating of the office, the board of selectmen shall
20 appoint a treasurer collector in accordance with section 1 of this act.

21 SECTION 3. No contracts or liabilities in force on the effective date of this act shall be
22 affected by the abolition of the elected offices of treasurer or collector or the creation of the
23 combined appointed office, and the appointed treasurer collector shall in all respects be the
24 lawful successor of the offices so abolished or consolidated. All records, property and
25 equipment whatsoever of the offices of the elected treasurer and elected collector shall be
26 assigned to the office of the appointed treasurer collector.

27 SECTION 4. This act shall take effect on its passage.
