An Act authorizing the town of Harvard to issue one-day liquor licenses.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The licensing authority of the town of Harvard may issue special one-day

2 licenses for the sale of all alcoholic beverages to be drunk on the premises pursuant to section 14

3 of chapter 138 of the General Laws and the granting of such licenses shall be subject to the same

4 conditions for the granting of licenses under section 12 of said chapter 138.
