## AN ACT RELATIVE TO VOTING PRECINCTS IN THE CITY OF REVERE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1	Section 1. Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, Ward 2,
2	Precinct 3 of the city of Revere shall be 1 precinct for the purpose of forming congressional,
3	representative, senatorial or councilor districts, but shall have 2 polling places for the purpose of
4	voting at any federal, state, or municipal elections. One of these polling places shall be located
5	at the Carl Hyman Towers located at 50 Walnut Avenue to serve voters residing on the north
6	side of Franklin avenue and shall be known as Precinct 3. The other polling place shall be
7	located at the Garfield School to serve the voters residing on the south side of Franklin Avenue,
8	west side of Walnut Avenue, north side of Hillside Avenue, north side of Revere Beach Parkway
9	and both sides of Hichborn Street to Franklin Avenue. This polling place shall be known as
10	ward 2, precinct 3A.

Section 2. Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, Ward 5,
Precinct 1 of the city of Revere shall be 1 precinct for the purpose of forming congressional,
representative, senatorial or councilor districts, but shall have 2 polling places for the purpose of

14 voting at any federal, state or municipal elections. One of these polling places shall be located at 15 the Point of Pines fire station located at 140 Lynnway to serve the voters residing north of Mills 16 Avenue at the point of intersection of Mills Avenue and North Shore Road. This includes 182-17 371 North Shore Road and 628-End Revere Beach Boulevard. This polling location shall be 18 known as Ward 5, Precinct 1. The other polling place shall be located at the Jack Satter House to 19 serve voters residing at the following addresses; 705 North Shore Road, 30-41 Oak Island Street 20 and 420-624 Revere Beach Boulevard and voters west of the Boston and Maine Railroad starting 21 at Oak Island Road. This polling location shall be known as Ward 5, Precinct 1A.

22 Section 3. Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, Ward 5, 23 Precinct 2, of the city of Revere shall be 1 precinct for the purpose of forming congressional, 24 representative, senatorial or councilor districts, but shall have 2 polling places for the purpose of 25 voting at any federal, state or municipal elections. One of these polling places shall be located at 26 the Jack Satter House located at 420 Revere Beach Boulevard to serve voters residing north of 27 Jackson Street and shall be known as ward 5 precinct 2. The other polling place shall be located at the Freeman street fire station to serve voters residing south of Jackson Street and shall be 28 29 known as ward 5 precinct 2A.

30 Section 4 The Election Commission of the city of Revere is hereby authorized to 31 take all necessary actions to assure compliance herewith including, but not limited to, such 32 actions as assuring the accuracy of the voting lists as located at each polling place as set forth in 33 this act. Said Election Commission shall divide each of the precincts set forth in sections one, 34 two and three into 2 sub precincts, in each of which is located 1 of the polling places set forth in 35 those sections, and only the names of voters who reside in each such sub precinct shall appear on 36 the voting list for said sub precinct. 37 Section 5. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
