Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- SECTION 1. Subsection (a) of section 7 of chapter 150E of the General Laws, as

 appearing in the 2010 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting after the word "years", in

 line 3, the following words:-; provided, however, that the employer and the exclusive

 representative through negotiation may agree to include a provision in a collective bargaining

 agreement stating that the agreement's terms shall remain in full force and effect beyond the 3

 years until a successor agreement is voluntarily negotiated by the parties.
 - SECTION 2. Section 1 shall apply to any collective bargaining agreement that: (i) contained a provision stating that the terms of the agreement remain in full force and effect beyond 3 years while the parties negotiate a successor agreement and (ii) expired before the effective date of this act; provided, however, its application to specific matters may be prohibited under section 3.
 - SECTION 3. Section 2 shall not apply to specific matters that were pending or adjudicated in a court of competent jurisdiction between October 22, 2010, and November 1, 2011; provided, however, that an agreement that has been the subject of such specific matters

- shall be in full force and effect for other specific matters if the agreement: (i) contained a
- provision stating that the terms of the agreement remain in full force and effect beyond 3 years
- while the parties negotiate a successor agreement and (ii) expired before the effective date of this
