By Ms. Spiliotis of Peabody, a petition (accompanied by bill, House, No. 3847) of Joyce A. Spiliotis (with the approval of the mayor and city council) relative to the Brooksby Village polling location in the city of Peabody. Election Laws. [Local Approval Received.]

An Act relative to a voting precinct in the City of Peabody.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, precinct 3 of
2 ward 4 of the city of Peabody shall be 1 precinct for the purpose of forming congressional,
3 representative, senatorial or councilor districts but shall have 2 polling places for the purposes of
4 voting at any state or municipal elections. One such polling location shall be in Brooksby Village
5 to serve voters residing within Brooksby Village and shall be known as precinct 3A of ward 4,
6 and the other polling location shall be designated by the city council under section 24 of chapter
7 54 of the General Laws to serve all others in precinct 3 of ward 4 and shall be known as precinct
8 3.

9 SECTION 2. The board of registrars of voters and the city clerk of the city of Peabody
10 shall take all necessary actions to assure compliance with this act including, but not limited to,
11 assuring the accuracy of the voting lists located at each polling location set forth in section 1.
12 The board of registrars and city clerk shall divide precinct 3 of ward 4 into subprecincts as set

13 forth in section 1, and only the names of voters who reside in each subprecinct shall appear on
14 the voting list for that subprecinct.

15 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
