An Act designating a certain bridge on Route 6 in the city of New Bedford as the Roland J. Hebert Bridge.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. The span of the New Bedford Fairhaven Bridge specifically the span  
2 between the mainland of New Bedford and Fish Island shall be dedicated as the Roland J. Hebert  
3 Bridge in honor of Roland J. Hebert, Deputy Director and Transportation Planning Manager of  
4 the Southeastern Planning & Economic Development District (SRPEDD), for his countless  
5 contributions and dedication to Southeastern Massachusetts and Transportation in Massachusetts.  
6 The department of transportation shall erect and maintain suitable markers bearing the  
7 designation in compliance with the standards of the department.
