Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- SECTION 1. Section 46A of Chapter 114 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2010
- 2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting, in line 6, after the word "permit," the following
- 3 words:-
- 4 "and the veterans' agent, appointed under section three of chapter one hundred and
- 5 fifteen,".
- 6 SECTION 2. Section 46A of Chapter 114 of the General Laws, as so appearing, is hereby
- amended by striking, in line 14, the words "board, body, or person" and inserting in the place
- 8 thereof, the following:- "veterans' agent".
