By Representative Dempsey of Haverhill and Senator Baddour, a joint petition (accompanied by bill, House, No. 3990) of Brian S. Dempsey (with the approval of the mayor and city council) for legislation to authorize the appointment of William M. Cowl, Jr. as a firefighter in the city of Haverhill notwithstanding the maximum age requirement. Public Service. [Local Approval Received.]

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year Two Thousand Twelve

An Act Authorizing the Appointment of William M. Cowl, Jr. as a Firefighter in the City of Haverhill Notwithstanding the Maximum Age Requirement.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 1. The personnel administrator of the human resources division shall certify
2 notwithstanding any general or special law or rule or regulation to the contrary William M.
3 Cowl, Jr. to be eligible for original appointment to the position of firefighter in the city of
4 Haverhill according to the grade he received on the examination for firefighter held in April of
5 2012, notwithstanding the maximum age for that position. If William M. Cowl, Jr. meets all
6 other requirements for certification as a firefighter, the city of Haverhill may appoint him.

7 Section 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
