By Mr. Costello of Newburyport, a petition (subject to Joint Rule 12) of Michael A. Costello for legislation to establish a sick leave bank for Michael Regan, an employee of the Massachusetts Department of Transportation. Public Service.

The Commonwealth of Alassachusetts

In the Year Two Thousand Twelve

An Act establishing a sick leave bank for Michael Regan, an employee of the Massachusetts Department of Transportation.

Whereas, The deferred operation of this act would tend to defeat its purpose, which is to establish a sick leave bank for a certain employee of the department of transportation, therefore it is hereby declared to be an emergency law, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public convenience.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Notwithstanding any general or special law, or rule, or regulation to the contrary, the

- department of transportation shall establish a sick leave bank for Michael W. Regan, an
- 3 employee of the office. Any employee of the office may voluntarily contribute 1 or more sick,
- 4 personal or vacation days to the sick leave bank for use by Michael W. Regan. Whenever
- 5 Michael W. Regan terminates employment with the office or requests to dissolve the sick leave
- 6 bank, any remaining time in the sick leave bank shall be transferred to the extended illness leave
- 7 bank. Sick leave bank days shall not be used for absences unrelated to the illness or disability
- 8 that necessitated the establishment of the sick leave bank as determined by the department of
- 9 transportation.
