An Act establishing a sick leave bank for Michael Regan, an employee of the Massachusetts Department of Transportation.

*Whereas*, The deferred operation of this act would tend to defeat its purpose, which is to establish a sick leave bank for a certain employee of the department of transportation, therefore it is hereby declared to be an emergency law, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public convenience.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           Notwithstanding any general or special law, or rule, or regulation to the contrary, the  
2 department of transportation shall establish a sick leave bank for Michael W. Regan, an  
3 employee of the office. Any employee of the office may voluntarily contribute 1 or more sick,  
4 personal or vacation days to the sick leave bank for use by Michael W. Regan. Whenever  
5 Michael W. Regan terminates employment with the office or requests to dissolve the sick leave  
6 bank, any remaining time in the sick leave bank shall be transferred to the extended illness leave  
7 bank. Sick leave bank days shall not be used for absences unrelated to the illness or disability  
8 that necessitated the establishment of the sick leave bank as determined by the department of  
9 transportation.
