An Act authorizing the continued employment of Thomas J. Osley, the chief of police of the town of Hatfield..

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, Thomas J.  
2   Osley, chief of the police department of the town of Hatfield, may continue to serve in such  
3   position until June 30, 2017, or until the date of his retirement or until his non-reappointment,  
4   whichever occurs first.

5           SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
