Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- SECTION 1. Section 2B of chapter 59 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2010
- 2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting, in line 18, after the words "and laws", the
- 3 following:
- 4 ; provided further, that, subject to section 4 of chapter 4, for the purposes of this section,
- 5 a farmers' market, as defined by the Massachusetts department of agricultural resources, shall be
- 6 considered a public purpose.
