### The Commonwealth of Alassachusetts

In the Year Two Thousand Twelve

An Act Establishing a Sick Leave Bank for Lawrence Marino, an Employee of the Massachusetts Department of Transportation.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Notwithstanding any general or special law, rule or regulation to the contrary, the
- 2 Department of Transportation shall establish a sick leave bank for Lawrence Marino, an
- 3 employee of the Department of Transportation. Any employee of the department may voluntarily
- 4 contribute 1 or more sick, personal or vacation days to the sick leave bank for use by Lawrence
- 5 Marino. Sick leave bank days shall not be used for absences unrelated to the illness or disability
- 6 that necessitated the establishment of the sick leave bank as determined by the department.
- 7 Whenever Lawrence Marino terminates employment with the department or requests to dissolve
- 8 the sick leave bank, any remaining time in the sick leave bank shall be transferred to the
- 9 extended illness leave bank.
