By Mr. Rosa of Leominster, a petition (subject to Joint Rule 12) of Dennis A. Rosa for legislation to establish a sick leave bank for Susan Tremblay, an employee of the Department of Correction. Public Service.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year Two Thousand Twelve

An Act establishing a sick leave bank for Susan Tremblay, an employee of the Department of Corrections.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Notwithstanding any general or special law or rule or regulation to the contrary, the
2 Department of Corrections shall establish a sick leave bank for Susan Tremblay, an employee of
3 the Department. Any employee of the department may voluntarily contribute 1 or more of his
4 sick, personal or vacation days to the sick leave bank for use by Susan Tremblay. Whenever
5 Susan Tremblay terminates employment with the department or requests to dissolve the sick
6 leave bank, the balance shall be transferred to the extended illness leave bank. Sick leave bank
7 days shall not be used for absences unrelated to the illness or disability that necessitated the
8 establishment of the sick leave bank as determined by the department.
