AN ACT AUTHORIZING ADAM A. SEGUIN TO TAKE THE CIVIL SERVICE
EXAMINATION FOR APPOINTMENT AS A POLICE OFFICER IN THE TOWN OF WARE
NOTWITHSTANDING THE MAXIMUM AGE REQUIREMENT.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority
of the same, as follows:*

1 Notwithstanding Chapter 31 of the General Laws or any other general or special law, or
2 rule or regulation to the contrary regulating the maximum age of an applicant for appointment as
3 a police officer, Adam A. Seguin of the town of Ware shall be eligible to take the next open,
4 competitive civil service examination for appointment to the position as police officer in the
5 town of Ware and, if he meets all other requirements, shall be eligible for certification and
6 appointment to such position.
