An Act designating a certain corner in the town of Watertown as Menton Corner.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           The intersection of Grove Street and Greenough Boulevard in the town of Watertown  
2 shall be designated and known as Menton Corner in honor of Judge Paul C. Menton, a World  
3 War II veteran, State Representative, and District Court judge who played a key role in creating  
4 this connection between East Watertown and Greenough Boulevard and the parklands adjacent  
5 thereto. The department of conservation and recreation shall erect and maintain a suitable marker  
6 bearing the designation in compliance with the standards of the department.
