An Act establishing a sick leave bank for Margaret A. Bagley, an employee of the Trial Court..

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           Notwithstanding any general or special law, rule or regulation to the contrary, the trial  
2 court shall establish a sick leave bank for Margaret A. Bagley, an employee of the department of  
3 the trial court. Any employee of the trial court may voluntarily contribute 1 or more sick,  
4 personal or vacation days to the sick leave bank for the use by Margaret A. Bagley. Sick leave  
5 bank days shall not be used for absences unrelated to the illness or disability that necessitated the  
6 establishment of the sick leave bank as determined by the trial court. Whenever Margaret A.  
7 Bagley terminates employment with the trial court or requests to dissolve the sick leave bank,  
8 any remaining time in the sick leave bank shall be transferred to the trial court paid leave bank.
