An Act Relative to the Position of Appointed Highway Surveyor in the Town of Hanson.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Notwithstanding section 1B of chapter 41 of the General Laws, or any other  
2   general or special law to the contrary, there shall be an appointed highway surveyor in the town  
3   of Hanson with all the powers and duties vested by law in said office. The highway surveyor  
4   shall be appointed and may be removed by the Hanson board of selectmen, and any vacancy in  
5   such office shall be filled in like manner.

6           SECTION 2. Notwithstanding section 1 of this act, the elected incumbent holding office  
7   as of the effective date of this act shall continue to hold such office and perform the duties  
8   thereof until an appointment to the position is made under said section 1. At such time, the  
9   position of elected highway surveyor shall be abolished, and the term of the incumbent  
10   terminated.

11          SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
