An Act authorizing Adam A. Seguin to take the civil service examination for appointment as a police officer in the town of Ware notwithstanding the maximum age requirement.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Notwithstanding chapter 31 of the General Laws or any other general or  
2   special law, or rule or regulation to the contrary regulating the maximum age of an applicant for  
3   appointment to the position of a police officer, Adam A. Seguin of the town of Ware shall be  
4   eligible to take the next open, competitive examination for appointment as a police officer in the  
5   town of Ware and, provided that he meets all other requirements, shall be eligible for  
6   certification and appointment to such position.

7           SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
