The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year Two Thousand Twelve

An Act Establishing a Sick Leave Bank for Wayne Murry.

Whereas, The deferred operation of this act would tend to defeat its purpose, which is to establish a sick leave bank for Wayne Murry, an employee of the Massachusetts Department of Transportation, therefore it is hereby declared to be an emergency law, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public convenience.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Notwithstanding any general or special law, the Massachusetts Department of
2 Transportation shall establish a sick leave bank for Wayne Murry, an employee of the
3 department. Any employee of the department may voluntarily contribute 1 or more sick,
4 personal or vacation days to the sick leave bank for use by Wayne Murry. Whenever Wayne
5 Murry terminates employment with the office or requests to dissolve the sick leave bank, any
6 remaining time in the sick leave bank shall be transferred to the extended illness leave bank. Sick
7 leave bank days shall not be used for absences unrelated to the illness or disability that
8 necessitated the establishment of the sick leave bank as determined by the department.
