By Mr. Donato of Medford, a petition (subject to Joint Rule 12) of Paul J. Donato for legislation to increase the membership of the commission on the status of grandparents raising grandchildren from 11 to 15 members and to allow for special appointments. Children, Families and Persons with Disabilities.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year Two Thousand Twelve

An Act increasing the membership of the permanent commission on the status of grandparents raising grandchildren.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section 69(a) of C. 3 of the Massachusetts General Laws is hereby amended as follows:
- 2 In line 2, the number 11 shall be replaced by the number 15
- 3 In lines 5 to 6 after the word “governor:” delete “1 person” and add “2 persons”
- 4 and after the word “representatives” add the following language: “and one of the persons
- 5 so appointed shall be a member of the House of Representatives.”
- 6 In lines 6 to 7 after the words “leader”, delete “1 person” and add “2 persons” and after
- 7 the word “senate” add the following language: “and one of the persons so appointed shall be a
- 8 member of the Massachusetts Senate.”
- 9 In line 7, strike the word “and”

10 In line 8 after “attorney general” add the following language “one appointment to be
11 made by the Chief Justice of the Probate and Family Court, said appointment to have
12 demonstrated a commitment to the rearing of grandchildren by grandparents and one
13 appointment to be made by the Chief Judge of the Juvenile Court, said appointment to have
14 demonstrated a commitment to the rearing of grandchildren by grandparents.”
