Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 3 of Chapter 209A of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2006
- 2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting after the word ?minor? in line 6 the following
- 3 words:-
- 4 ; ordering the possession, care and control of any animal owned, possessed, leased, kept,
- 5 or held by either party or a minor child residing in the household to the plaintiff. The court may
- 6 order the defendant to refrain from abusing, threatening, taking, interfering with, transferring,
- 7 encumbering, concealing, harming, or otherwise disposing of the animal;
