An Act relative to the payment of certain fines for non criminal hearings.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           Section 1. The first paragraph (4) of subsection (A) of section 3 of chapter 90C of the  
2 General Laws

3           is hereby amended by striking out the last sentence, added, by 73 of chapter 27 of the acts  
4 of 2009.

5           Section 2. The fourth paragraph of subsection (A) of said section 3 of said chapter 90C is  
6 hereby amended by

7           striking the second sentence and inserting in place thereof the following sentence- Any  
8 violator so appealing the decision shall

9           not pay a fee prior to the scheduling of the appeal hearing before a justice.
