Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section 1. Section 2 of chapter 93A of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2008
- 2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by adding the following paragraph:-
- 3 (d) All legal claims including but not limited to double and triple damages and attorney
- 4 fees under this chapter shall come with a right to a jury trial.
- 5 Section 2. Paragraph (a) of section 9 of chapter 93A of the General Laws as so
- 6 appearing, is hereby amended by adding the following sentence:-
- A technical violation of a legally protected interest alone without an actual and not future
- 8 or perceived injury would be insufficient to bring an action under this section.
