An Act relative to the Franklin and Hampshire counties juvenile court.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           Section 58 of chapter 218 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2004 Official Edition,  
2 is hereby amended by striking out, in line 9 of the fourth paragraph, the words “the Franklin and  
3 Hampshire counties division shall have an assistant clerk” and inserting the words “the Franklin  
4 and Hampshire counties division shall have a first assistant clerk and one assistant clerk”.
