An Act penalizing any offender in possession of marijuana in a school zone.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 32J of chapter 94C of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2006
2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting, in the third line after the letter” I”, the
3 following words:-
4 , and, notwithstanding the provisions of chapter 387 of the acts of 2008, is in possession
5 of any amount of marijuana and
