An Act relative to rent escrow.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 8A of chapter 239 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2008
2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by striking out the word “and” in line 30.

3 SECTION 2. Said section 8A of said chapter, as so appearing, is hereby further amended
4 by inserting, after the word “vacated;”, in line 32, the following clause:-

5 and (5) the tenant or occupant deposits with the clerk all rent due prior to final
6 disposition of the plaintiff’s action;
