*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1           SECTION 1. Section 87 of chapter 149 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2004  
2   Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting, in line 28, after the words “by said physician”  
3   the words:— “within twenty-four months prior to the date on said certificate”.
