In the Year Two Thousand Eleven

An Act relative to certain Option B and Option C retirees..

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of any general or special law to the contrary, a
2 member, who is receiving a lesser retirement allowance in accordance with the terms of Option
3 B or Option C of Section 12 of Chapter 32 of the General Laws, from a retirement system that
4 accepts the provisions of this act, shall have his retirement allowance determined according to
5 the table of mortality selected by the commission pursuant to Section 336 of Chapter 47 of the
6 Acts of 2004 and whatever section governs the Option B amount. For purposes of this Act, the
7 State Teachers' and State Employees' Retirement Systems shall be deemed to have accepted the
8 provisions of this Act.
