An Act relative to the retirement rights of forest and park supervisors.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Section 3 of Chapter 32 of the Massachusetts General Laws, as most  
2 recently amended by chapter 308 of the acts of 2008, is hereby further amended by inserting in  
3 group 4, after the words “Massachusetts firefighting academy,” the following words:-  
  
4           the two Forest and Park Supervisors in the Division of State Parks and Recreation in the  
5 Department of Conservation and Recreation who supervise and instruct inmate crews of the  
6 M.C.I. Forestry Camp of Myles Standish State Park,
