**In the Year Two Thousand Eleven**

An Act to include certain employees of the Commonwealth in Group Two of the state retirement system.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Section 3 of Chapter 32 of the General Laws is hereby amended by  
2 inserting in the definition of Group 2 therein, after the words, “wayward children” the following  
3 new words:- or employees of the Commonwealth whose regular and major duties require them to  
4 have daily contact with prisoners under the department of correction or parolees or persons who  
5 are mentally ill or persons who are mentally defective or defective delinquents or wayward  
6 children or persons who are patients in institutions of the Commonwealth
