An Act relative to eligibility for state group health insurance.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Section 2(e) of Chapter 32A of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2004  
2   Official Edition, is amended in line 94 by inserting after the word “hours” the following:  
  
3           or faculty who teach the equivalent of at least two three or more- credit courses per  
4   semester or four three or more- credit courses per calendar year at one of more state higher  
5   education institutions, including a division of continuing education, regardless of funding source,  
6   including but not limited to subsidiary account CC, and regardless of the term of employment
