Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 3 of Chapter 32 of the General Laws subsection (g) as appearing in the 2004
2 Official Edition shall be amended in Group 4 by adding in line 298 after the words “county
3 correction facilities” the following:-

4 Employees of the trial court who hold the position of assistant chief probation officer,
5 probation officer in charge, probation officer and associate probation officer or assistant chief
6 court officer court officer I , court officer II .
